1. EXHIBITION & INSTALLATION MANAGER (CONTRACT): The Lake George Arts Project (LGAP) Exhibition & Installation Manager is an important part of the LGAP team and is responsible for working with artists to create an exhibition content package and for the preparation, installation, and deinstallation of exhibitions and/or public art projects. This position plays a critical role in ensuring artwork is handled, installed, and presented safely, professionally, and in alignment with the organization's artistic standards. The ideal candidate is hands-on, dependable, and comfortable working with a wide range of media in both indoor gallery settings and outdoor/public environments.

2. COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT COORDINATOR (30 HOURS): LGAP seeks an organized and creative Community Engagement Coordinator to assist with the planning, coordination, and execution of the organization's public-facing programs. This role is central to our mission of supporting artists and expanding access to high-quality arts experiences for residents and visitors of the Lake George region.
