Saratoga County History Center at Brookside Museum is proud to present a program focusing on the musical legacy of the Anti-Rent movement in Upstate New York. Upstate New York's Anti-Rent Movement is considered the last struggle over feudalism in the United States. Tenant farmers in the Hudson-Mohawk region engaged in organized protest throughout the 1840s to contest monopoly ownership of the land they worked. Arguing their cause in newspapers, on broadsides, and at rallies, their aspirations also took shape in poetry and song. During this presentation, taking place on August 30 at 2 PM, discussion of this major 19th-century reform movement will be interspersed with Anti-Rent songs from broadsides and newspapers.
